Rules

- ❖ Three minutes per item unless otherwise specified.
- ❖ Time limits specified in the Syllabus will be adhered to. A bell will be rung 15 seconds before the finish of Impromptu Mimes, Talks and Improvisations.
- ❖ For impromptu pieces, including improvisations, mimes and reading at sight, competitors will be shown the topic and given 30 seconds before a bell is rung and their performance and time commences.
- ❖ For impromptu talks competitors will receive one (1) minute to consider their topic before the bell rings and their performance and time commences.
- ❖ It is the competitors responsibility to organise their own requirements for all performances.
- ❖ One (1) minute is given for the setting of scenes and group items and one (1) minute for striking.
- ❖ Restricted verse may be performed in own selection class (Refer Rule 20)
- ❖ Scenes involve two (2) or more competitors
- ❖ Group speaking involves eight (8) or more competitors
- ❖ Titles of all selections must be shown on entry form.
- ❖ Copies of all own selections, including readings, are to be submitted to the convenor the Friday before the competitions commence. Only **TYPEWRITTEN** copies of selections will be accepted. Each copy **MUST** include the competitors name and the class number. (Refer Rule 7)

WELCOME

The committee of the Manawatu Performing Arts Competition Society Inc welcomes you all to the 102nd centenary festival. We hope you will enjoy your time with us.

During the festival the committee and helpers are available to assist you with queries and to ensure that everything runs smoothly, so please do not hesitate to approach us if required.

Venue:

We are again using the Speirs Centre, a lovely venue with free parking onsite.

Please note: The large Mitre 10 car park opposite the Speirs Centre does have parking restrictions so you are advised to check these to avoid incurring a fine.

Competitors are expected to be at the venue prior to the start of each session, with competitors from the first 3 scheduled classes reporting to the stage manager 20 minutes prior to the session start time. Also note that some classes may be called 2 or 3 classes at a time.

For classes such as impromptu, reading at sight, test pieces and improvisations competitors are sequestered in the dressing rooms and cell phones are not allowed.

There is a large back stage area for props, costumes and practice. Ideally costumes should be worn backstage, not in the auditorium, to ensure the 'surprise' of the costume for the audience.

New Competitors will be called prior to the start of a session for a stage walk, time to experience standing on stage and looking out to the audience. During lunch & dinner time, respectful use of the stage is permitted for character or scene staging.

Results and feedback:

Feedback and results will occur at the end of each session, ie -

approx. 11.30am and 4.30pm and at the end of the evening session.

Competitors should be present for this results time, to receive placings and cups and because the feedback can enable understanding and improvement. We have been lucky to secure Glenda Pearce, a very experienced adjudicator, with a wealth of knowledge to share with us.

Competitor results sheets, with the mark and comments about their performance, are available after the results of each session. We encourage all competitors to collect these and read them.

The competitions conclude with a **Grand Prize Giving** at the end of the Monday afternoon session. This is where convenor awards, the special awards and the age awards are presented. We ask that all competitors attend the grand prize giving if possible.

The motto of our competitions is **"give it a go and have fun"**. We encourage everyone, within the spirit of competition, to be supportive of all those who perform to whatever is the best of their ability. We acknowledge those who help and support others.

Special thanks to all those teachers, parents and their students who continue to support the Society and in doing so ensure the ongoing success of the annual competition festival.
